

Public Enemy #1

The mistake is often made of thinking that we are the first and only generation, the holders of all worthwhile knowledge! The wisdom of previous ages is deemed inadequate for the challenges of today.

Yet, if we look to political advice given in the 16th century by political strategist Niccolò Machiavelli, we see that political chicaneries have long been practiced by the ruling class...in the past and still today.

The establishment of a common enemy was applauded by Niccolò Machiavelli: “a capable and courageous Prince will always overcome these difficulties, now, by holding out hopes to his subjects that the evil will not be of long continuance, now, by exciting their fears of the enemies’ cruelty” (*The Prince*).¹ Give people a common enemy, someone or something to be greatly feared, then unite them under the rewards given upon deliverance from the enemy. Fear and hope together!

Today, we who care about freedom and national sovereignty are haunted by the spectre of globalism: an international power grab by the United Nations and its “New World Order” allies.

Fear is an effective catalyst for manipulating duly elected national governments into submission to the “one world government” envisioned by the UN elite. The appeal is for the common good and against the common enemy of the day. That enemy might be “climate change” or “COVID-19” or “scarce resources” or “overpopulation”, all of which have had their day. At the moment, it might seem that the common enemy (Public Enemy #1) is COVID-19 but that could change quickly, as it already has. It certainly has gripped world attention and responses to it have dramatically affected the economy, public policy and possibly the US elections. A tiny germ, too small to be seen, has brought mighty nations to their knees. Will it play a part in the surrender of national sovereignty to the UN?

The push by the UN over the past couple of decades has been for fighting “climate change”; that issue has been both a unifier and a divider. The majority has accepted the CO2 premise, along with the taxes and lifestyle changes dictated by the elite; but those who reject the narrative are vilified if they won't fall into step with the battle against the UN's idea of “Public Enemy #1”. We see Machiavelli's advice put into action—the hope of a golden future is promised, with the caveat that first we must overcome the evil of “climate change” and “climate change deniers”.

George Orwell, in his classic book, *1984*, gave us a stunning description of how loyalties can be shifted to the all-powerful state. He told of children being inducted into an organization called the “Junior Spies”, where they were brainwashed and encouraged to spy on their parents. Children, whose loyalties were shifted to Big Brother, became willing to report on their parents to the Party.

We see similar pressure from the UN in their endorsement of Greta Thunberg. As she urges students to skip classes to protest climate change, she also condemns current and previous generations of adults for their inaction. She insists that it has been left to children to demand climate action. “How dare you!” is her outraged cry to adults. She attracts an ever-growing following. However, her personal dependence on single-use plastics, which brimmed out of her rental car while she was in Canada² is evidence that it is easier to talk the talk than to walk the walk. She has become a tool of the powerful UN, which seeks a mandate to govern without the messiness of elections.

Now, more than ever, we must be vigilant in protecting our sovereignty as a nation. As fears about the future continue to grow, we must make a conscious decision to protect the sovereignty of our country. How do we do that against powerful bullying left wing activists?

CHP Canada affirms our position that “it is unwise to work toward a one-world government under which all nations would be asked to give up their national sovereignty.” Further, CHP’s policy is to “support the United Nations as originally constituted; however, we must not let wishful thinking blind us to the organization’s serious and costly defects.”

The original mandate of the United Nations was fourfold:
